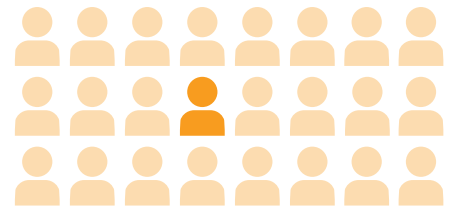

ABUSE & NEGLECT

24% of children who were the subject of a substantiated report suffered from neglect.

MENTAL ILLNESS

Parental mental illness is a major cause of child abuse and neglect.

HOMELESSNESS

27% of people experiencing homelessness are children under the age of 18 years.

POVERTY

17.4% of all Australian children under 15 years live below the poverty line. (One in six)

DISABILITY

Disabled children and young people are three times more likely to be abused or neglected.

FAMILY VIOLENCE

Children who were physically or sexually abused before the age of 15 years were three times as likely to experience domestic violence after the age of 15.
