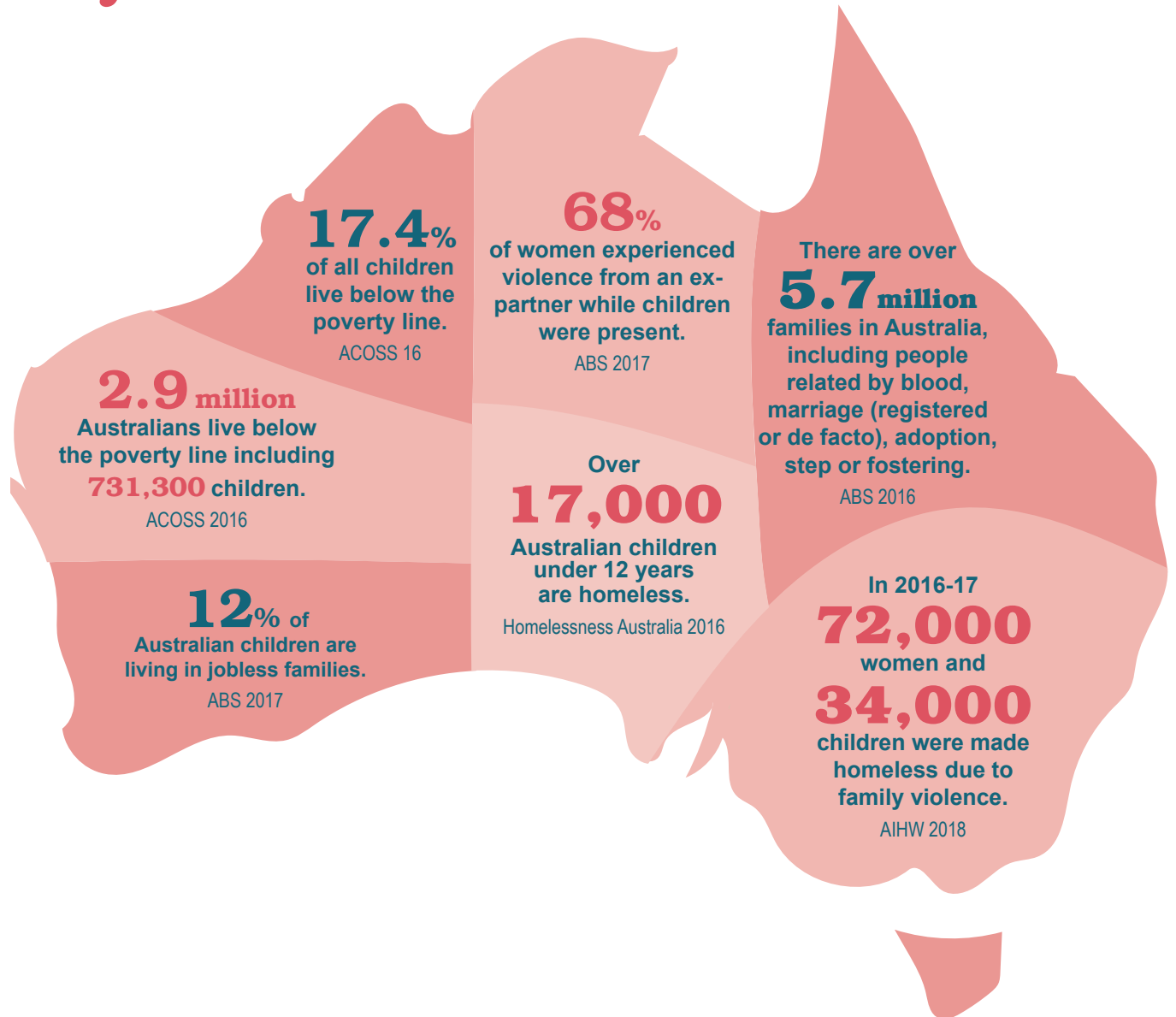

Key Issues

CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT

In 2016/17, **67,890** children were the subject of a substantiated report of child abuse or neglect.

SINGLE PARENT HARDSHIP

Single parent families are three times more likely to be living in poverty than two parent families.

DISABILITY

Almost 7% of children aged 0-14 years with a severe disability live in low-income households.

HOMELESSNESS

Over one third of people seeking specialist homelessness services were escaping domestic and family violence. **34%** of these were children under the age of 18 years.
