TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The manuscript must be a work of non-fiction between 70,000 – 90,000 words, and must be written in English.
2. The manuscript submitted must be complete and must be suitable for the Australian popular readers' market.
3. The competition is open to memoirs that include some sense of an Australian family – whatever that means to the Author.
4. The competition is open to living writers, whether they have been published before or not. However your submitted work must not be under contract/option to any other publisher. Self-published works in print or eBook may be submitted, but they must be withdrawn from sale if the manuscript is short listed.
5. Entrants must be permanent residents of Australia.
6. In entering the competition you warrant that:
 - (i) The entry is an original work, which has not been published or made available in any form anywhere throughout the world.
 - (ii) That it is in no way whatever an infringement of any existing copyright or licence or any other right of any person.
 - (iii) That it contains no defamatory matter, or any matter which invades any individual's rights of privacy.
 - (iv) All statements in the work purporting to be facts are true.
7. Each entry must be received by post, and must contain the following:
 - (i) This entry form
 - (ii) The first three chapters of a complete manuscript, double spaced, single sided and at 12pt font, with the author's name on the first page only
 - (iii) A synopsis of no more than 200 words
 - (iv) An entry fee of \$50.00
8. The short listed entries will be asked to submit the full manuscript posted within 5 days of the request.
 - (i) Where a full manuscript is unavailable, entries, will be disqualified
9. The Prize is open for submissions from Sunday June 1, 2014 All entries must be received by Barnardos Australia no later than 4pm 31 August, 2014 by post.
10. An author may submit more than one manuscript, but each entry must be accompanied by an entry form and fee.
11. Electronic submissions will not be accepted
12. The winner will be notified by phone and/or email.
13. The winner will be announced on Friday November 1, 2014 on the Barnardos Australia website (www.barnardos.org.au) and in the media.
14. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into either during or after the judging process.
15. Chance plays no part in determining the winner. Entries will be judged in regard to literary merit and commercial potential in today's book markets. Only one prize will be awarded.
16. Submitted manuscripts will not be returned. Do not submit any creative materials apart from your written entry. Keep a copy of your entry for your reference.

19. The winner receives representation by the Selwa Anthony Author Management Agency and a guaranteed publishing contract for print, eBook and an audio book.
