Barnardos Auburn Children's Family Centre provides practical support and assistance to families when it is most needed.

Our services include:

- Child care
- Family support
- Domestic violence support
- Youth support
- Transitional accommodation
- Child and adolescent sexual assault counselling
- Temporary family care
- Kinship care

Our staff speak a variety of different languages and respect all cultures in our community.

Family Support

We offer practical parenting help and education. We understand that your family is under stress and needs help. Our program offers home visiting.

We work with families who are experiencing:

- social isolation
- parenting difficulties
- financial stress

Domestic Violence Support

We offer support to families that have experienced or are currently experiencing domestic violence.

We offer home visiting, court support, safety planning and domestic violence education.

Our support is tailored to meet your family's individual needs.

Youth Support

We offer mentoring support to vulnerable young people between 12-18 years. This service offers home visiting, advice and information to families.

Child and Adolescent Sexual Assault Counselling

We offer specialist sexual assault counselling and education to victims and their families at our centre.

Temporary Family Care (TFC)

Our short-term foster care program has authorised foster carers who look after young children and their siblings if they cannot live safely at home. TFC works together with the family, government and other agencies for children to eventually return home as part of restoration, live with other family members or a permanent safe home for the long term.
