## Out-of-home care

**45,000** children and young people are unable to live with their parents due to abuse and neglect. **47%** or more than **22,000** children in out-of-home care are aged 10-17 years. AIHW 2018/19



## Care leavers Within one year of

exiting out-of-home care, **50%** of care leavers will be unemployed, in jail, homeless or become a new parent.

## Homelessness

Alcohol and illicit drug use were the **leading causes** of total burden of disease in males aged 15–24 and the second and third leading causes (respectively) for females.

- Reconnect Program reconnects young people with their families to prevent youth homelessness.

- Joint Support Program provides support to young people involved in the Juvenile Justice system in the areas of education, employment and accommodation.
