The Auburn Children's Family Centre has been in operation since 1974 and has a long-standing, well respected relationship with the local community.

Our evidence-informed programs and expert staff provide critical and practical support to families when it is needed the most.

Our services include:

- Child care
- Family support
- Domestic violence support
- Youth support
- Transitional accommodation
- Child and famliy counselling
- Temporary family care
- Kinship care

Our staff speak a variety of different languages and are respectful of all cultures. We welcome families of all backgrounds.

Support services

Transitional Accommodation Program

At Barnardos we believe that everyone should have access to a safe home. Our team will work with families to prevent them and their children from becoming homeless.

We offer accommodation for families with dependent children and pregnant women aged between 16-24 years. Our caseworkers will support them to transition into other housing, including private rental.

Auburn Early Learning Centre

The education and well-being of children is our priority at all times. At our not-for-profit centre, we offer early childhood education and care services for children aged 2-5 years old with long day-care hours. We also have staff trained in caring for children with special needs.

Family Support

We offer practical parenting help and educational programs. We understand that families can be under a lot of stress and offer home visits.

In particular, we work with families who are experiencing:

- social isolation
- parenting difficulties
- financial stress

Domestic Violence Support

We offer support to families that have experienced or are currently experiencing domestic violence. We offer home visiting, court support, safety planning and domestic violence education. Our support is tailored to meet the family's individual needs.

Youth Support

We offer mentoring support to vulnerable young people between 12-18 years. This service offers home visiting, advice and information to families.

Child and Family Counselling

We offer specialist sexual assault counselling and education to victims and their families at our centre.

Foster care

Our short-term foster care program has authorised foster carers who look after young children and their siblings if they cannot live safely at home. We work together with the family, government and other agencies so that children can return home as part of restoration, live with other family members in our Kinship Care program, or in a permanent, safe home for the long term.
