

State of Shellharbour's Children Report 2019 Launch

The Shellharbour community will gain an insight into what life is like for local children next Wednesday 16th October with the launch of the *State of Shellharbour's Children* Report.

The report, produced by Barnardos Australia, who delivers the government funded Communities for Children program in the region, provides a snapshot of how Shellharbour children are developing as compared with state and national benchmarks.

Based on overwhelming evidence that early childhood experiences set the tone for a child's future, the report closely monitors children's holistic development in the region to shape investment in services whilst giving children a voice in matters affecting them.

By collaborating with children and collating relevant data and recent research, the report identifies gaps in service and areas for growth, tracking outcomes and impact of investment in services. By providing a holistic view of the Shellharbour community, the report enables those working with children and families to provide more targeted and effective programs.

Recognising that children's development occurs within five key systems, the report investigates the domains of home, learning, family, wellbeing and community. For example, the report shows a favourable increase in immunisation rates and steady NAPLAN results, whilst socio-economic indexes show a concerning level of disadvantage in some areas which require continued focus.

Copies of the report which will be available to the public at the launch, which will be followed by a community consultation workshop session with those in attendance.
