

Issues facing young people in Australia



Out-of-home care

46,000 children and young people are unable to live with their parents due to abuse and neglect. **47%** or more than **22,000** children in out-of-home care are aged 10-17 years.

Substance abuse

Alcohol and illicit drug use were the **leading causes** of total burden of disease in males aged 15-24 and the second and third leading causes (respectively) for females.

Mental health

1 in 7 children and young people aged 4 - 17 years experience a mental health condition in any given year.

Homelessness

24,200 young people aged 15-24 experienced homelessness on Census night 2016.

Abuse

1 in 6 girls and **1 in 9** boys were physically and/or sexually abused before the age of 15.

Care leavers

Within one year of exiting out-of-home care, **50%** of care leavers will be unemployed, in jail, homeless or become a new parent.
