### Child abuse and neglect



#### Child deaths

There were approximately 30 victims of filicide in **2018** (killing of a child or children under 18 by a parent or parent-equivalent) accounting for 16% of all domestic homicides.

# Parental drug abuse

Children whose parents use drugs are **3 times** more likely to be physically, sexually and emotionally abused, and 4 times more likely to be neglected.

# **How Barnardos helps**

We keep vulnerable children and young people safe from abuse and neglect by assisting families facing issues such as violence, poverty, homelessness, drug and alcohol misuse and mental illness.



We give parents the tools and confidence to care for their children, encouraging them to be their child's first teacher, strengthening parent-child relationships and their connection to community.



We focus on early learning, school readiness and engagement. We also provide breakfast clubs and homework support through our Aboriginal learning centres.



We assist families with complex issues such as domestic violence, poverty, homelessness, drug and alcohol misuse and mental illness through wraparound services and specialist Aboriginal programs.



We provide youth homelessness services, counselling and mediation, mentoring and advocacy, youth drop-in and street outreach programs, drug and alcohol services, and juvenile justice support.



We provide short-term foster care while we work with birth parents to have their children restored. If the courts rule a child cannot safely return home, we provide permanent foster care and open adoption.
